HARNETT COUNTY
COURTS FACILITY SECURITY

It having been brought to the attention of the undersigned that there are articles available that pose a serious and present threat to the security of the Harnett County Courts Facility and to persons using such Facility.

Specifically, stun guns and firearms are being produced disguised as cell phones and calculators are being produced containing concealed knives. In addition, cell phones and other electronic devices have been used to photograph and videotape witnesses during testimony, thereby posing a threat to their personal safety.

To provide for the safety and security of the Harnett County Courts Facility, **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Harnett County Sheriff shall, using his best judgment, ban cell phones, electronic devices and any other item or article from the Courts Facility that, in the judgment of the Sheriff, pose a security threat to the Facility or to the public using such Facility.

This Order is entered this 11th day of April 2016 and will be effective the 18th day of April 2016 and shall be posted at all entrances of the Harnett County Courts Facility.
